Request for Proposal (RFP) Letters will be sent out soon via email to past applicants as well as any new non-profit organization interested in applying for a grant. The RFP letter delineates the criteria that potential applicants must meet to submit an application and be considered for a grant. "We are so excited to once again be able to support

local schools, religious organizations of all denominations, and other charitable groups with their community projects. Last year, the Rancho Santa Fe Garden Club awarded over \$130,000 to worthy San Diego organizations, and partnered with The Agrarian Institute to provide a \$100,000 grant to be distributed over four years," said Steven Winters, president of RSFGC.

The deadline to submit an application is Friday, December 8, 2023.
